Thrive to Survive 2020 Annual Report



Dear Thrive to Survive Friends,

2020 has come to a close. Serendipitously, the COVID19 pandemic provided a rare opportunity for Thrive to Survive to reflect on our survivors, mission, programs, and services. Throughout the pandemic, Thrive to Survive has persevered in spite of many limitations and obstacles. To cope with the virus, we retreated to our homes and established new practices that allowed us to continue to support survivors diagnosed and being treated for cancer.

The pandemic impacted every aspect of operating our non-profit. Thrive to Survive made the choice to cancel all fundraising and postponed our MF5K until 2021. Friendly Ford annual fund raising had to be rescheduled and converted to a virtual test drive event. Many in our community were determined to help and created unique fund-raising opportunities that allowed participants to stay safe while raising much needed funding to support Thrive to Survive. Thrive to Survive allocates all funding to support our survivors and the programs and services we provide to help them Thrive through their diagnosis. Thrive to Survive does not have the usual expenses of running a non-profit: payroll, rent/mortgage, utilities, etc. Therefore, Thrive to Survives financial position is strong, stable and will persist well into the future.

Starting in April, our monthly general cancer support group began meeting virtually. Our group facilitator, Karen held monthly zoom caring and sharing time for our survivors and their caregivers. In addition, she coordinated speakers, wellness programs and group art projects. Our members also planted a memorial garden and painted kindness rocks while socially distancing last spring. Online meetings have provided members an outlet for dealing with the challenges of cancer and the ability to stay connected socially. All while being in the comfort of their own homes, safe and socially distant.

The pandemic did not slow the rate of cancer diagnosis during 2020, nor did it reduce the need for Thrive to Survive programs and services. Thrive to Survive provided 92 emergency financial grants, over 150 pick me ups, distributed over 200 distraction bags to newly diagnosed cancer survivors, provided special phone support, research assistance, and extra aid for survivors to obtain out of area treatments and assist with travel costs. It is a blessing that Thrive to Survive was able to help alleviate emotional and financial stress for survivors and their families.

As always, we are deeply grateful to our dedicated supporters that choose to believe, follow, support and for making all of our achievements possible. In 2021, we look forward to providing opportunities for survivors and families to create meaningful connections, offer critical support and opportunities for unique experiences that build wellness and improve emotional wellbeing. Thrive to Survive exists to help survivors overcome their challenges and navigate cancer.

Thrive to Survive Program Spotlight

All Thrive to Survive programs and services are available free and open to adults aged 18+ living in Ontario, Yates, Seneca and Schuyler, and Wayne Counties.

Thrive to Survive General Cancer Support Group Meetings

Providing free monthly support group meetings to anyone affected by cancer, including caregivers and those who are bereaved. TTS understands the complex issues surrounding a cancer diagnosis and treatment. Our support group facilitator knows the importance of getting help and providing a safe environment to share and participate in activities that help to reduce stress and anxiety. Our facilitator provided emotional and practical support to 19 participants on average each month.

Thrive to Survive Financial Grants

Financial assistance programing is available to assist with the high costs of treatment, copays, travel expenses, and general living expenses. Funding is available to survivors who have received surgery, chemotherapy or radiation therapy within 12 months of their cancer diagnosis. In 2020, we provided 92 financial grants to area survivors.

Thrive to Survive Pick Me Ups

When Board members learn about someone recently diagnosed with cancer, we spring into action and write an encouraging note to the survivor. In addition to our note card, we include a small gift card to a local store that can be used to pay for medication or possibly a healthy meal. This is our way of introducing the survivor to Thrive to Survive and the services we offer to cancer patients. Thrive to Survive provided 39 pick me ups during 2020.

Thrive to Survive Distraction Tool Kit Gift bags

Through the generous support of the Florence M. Muller Foundation, Thrive to Survive started assembling custom bags filled with useful items for someone in treatment in 2018. With the help of local volunteers, Thrive to Survive distraction toolkits are delivered to treatment centers in Geneva, Clifton Springs and Canandaigua. The doctors and nurses at these treatment centers distribute bags to new patients. Bags include items like: notepad, pen, calendar, lap blanket, lip balm, hand lotion, and puzzle books.

Thrive to Survive Middle Finger 5K

As you are aware, to maintain everyone's health and safety the 2020 Middle Finger 5K was postponed to May 1, 2021. That is not without huge support and sponsorship for the 2020 event. Our registration numbers had a 32% decrease after postponing the race, however, our fundraising efforts were about the same. \$47,625.10 was raised. All 884 participants are all set to go for the 2021 event.


