Thrive to Survive is entering our 11th year of providing essential cancer support services to the Finger Lakes region. For the last three years, Covid19 has played a significant role in reducing our Board's ability to provide in person services as well as limited our ability to fundraise. Knowing how important our programs and services are to our survivors, we found alternative methods to continue all services. Our support group and yoga classes moved to online zoom meetings, and we never turned down a single request for financial assistance. Our board has been fiscally responsible with every penny received, thus allowing us to have a comfortable cushion to rely upon during Covid19.

Our board is committed to helping any adult in the designated Finger Lakes counties to THRIVE through their cancer diagnosis. Services are provided to adults regardless of race, gender, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, disability, economic status, or other diverse backgrounds. We understand the high cost of care and the difficulty of accessing care in our rural communities. Thrive to Survive is here to help ensure that adults affected by cancer have access to the support they need and deserve.

## How Thrive to Survive Helps

Founded in 2012, Thrive to Survive is the Finger Lakes leading organization providing support services to assist adults with managing the emotional, physical, and financial challenges of cancer. Our services include support groups, health and wellness programs, and financial assistance.

Thrive to Survive has helped thousands of survivors and their families. We provide a safe space for survivors, their caregivers and families impacted by cancer to connect with others who can relate to their experiences. Our group is run by our experienced facilitator, Karen Cardillo, who leads participants in mindful, relaxing activities and discussions. Monthly activities are set up based on the needs of the group. This year we hosted 12 monthly meetings, two special events and a holiday party. Our group leader also provides individualized support in unique situations when one on one support was needed.

Health and wellness programs – we have collaborated with the Geneva Family YMCA and other talented wellness instructors to provide in person and online classes for our survivors to help build stamina and regain health after treatments.


Our financial assistance program provides monetary funding to help bridge the gap when cancer treatment related costs like transportation, co-pay assistance, childcare, transportation, and assistance for the day-today cost of living exceed a family's budget. We have awarded over \$535,000 in cancer support assistance over the last 11 years and assisted thousands of people.


#### Our 2021-22 mission was funded by Revenue:
